# EDITORIAL

## LOOKING BACK . . . MOVING FORWARD

Writing this editorial is like a diary of my own journey with PAPA. The maiden issue of the newsletter came out in 2019, several months after PAPA celebrated its 25th Anniversary with the tagline “5 in 25” highlighting 5 successful advocacies in 25 years. This was followed by 4 more issues which aimed to inform and update members of what committee members were busy about and other upcoming activities they could participate in. So much had happened since then and all these were chronicled in the past issues. The accomplishments of PAPA during the leadership of Dr. Wenslyn Salvador, who by the way prodded me to initiate the newsletter, were well documented in these publications; and now, with the dynamic Dr. Edna Sarah Morada, the current president, ending her 2-year term soon, I shall summarize some notable achievements during her leadership.

Despite the government’s health restrictions imposed during the past 3 years, the officers and members’ passion and dedication kept them on their toes. Rather than consider this as a threat that may thwart organizational plans, PAPA took this as an opportunity to reach a wider audience through digital means. Two successful annual conventions were held online and another one coming this March. Several webinars aimed to create awareness of who we are and what we do as an organization were initiated by each advocacy committee.

Moreover, to enhance learning among our members and non-members alike, these well-attended pediatric webinars, spearheaded by the indefatigable committee chairs and chapter presidents, also emphasized ways of improving child health and gave updates on management of child’s diseases, the details of which will be seen in the succeeding pages of this issue.

A total of 16 local and 16 international notable and accomplished physicians in their fields, were inducted to the organization in the past 2 years. The establishment of a collaborative partnership with our fellow pediatricians based in the US through the International Affiliate Committee has come into fruition last year which led to the birth of the mental health advocacy group. This group is preparing a project that will help improve the mental health status of children. As their year ender, a fun-filled, eye-opening trip to Bataan to meet the grade-school parents, grade-school teachers and the principal of North Samal Elementary

School provided the group an opportunity to connect with people from the grassroots, the target of the Mental Health project. Notwithstanding the busyness of the season, it was a breather for those who joined this field trip, a way to connect and catch up after 2 years seeing each other via zoom.

The Strategic Planning Workshop held early last year strengthened our resolve to pursue our vision and mission despite the challenges of the pandemic.

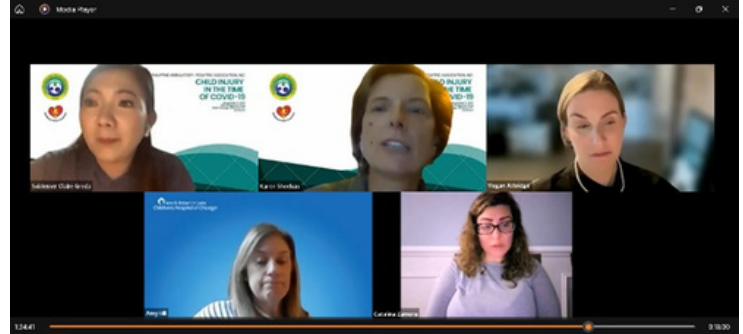

## Analysis of quantitative data

Rule out bias by:

- Choosing a representative sample (for cross-sectional studies)
- Ensuring that comparison groups are comparable (for cohort, case-control, quasi-experiments, and trials). This includes doing randomization when possible.
- Using validated instruments and calibrated measurements and using objective data sources.
- Doing blinding (in trials)
- Minimizing loss to follow-up (for cohort and trials) and missing data

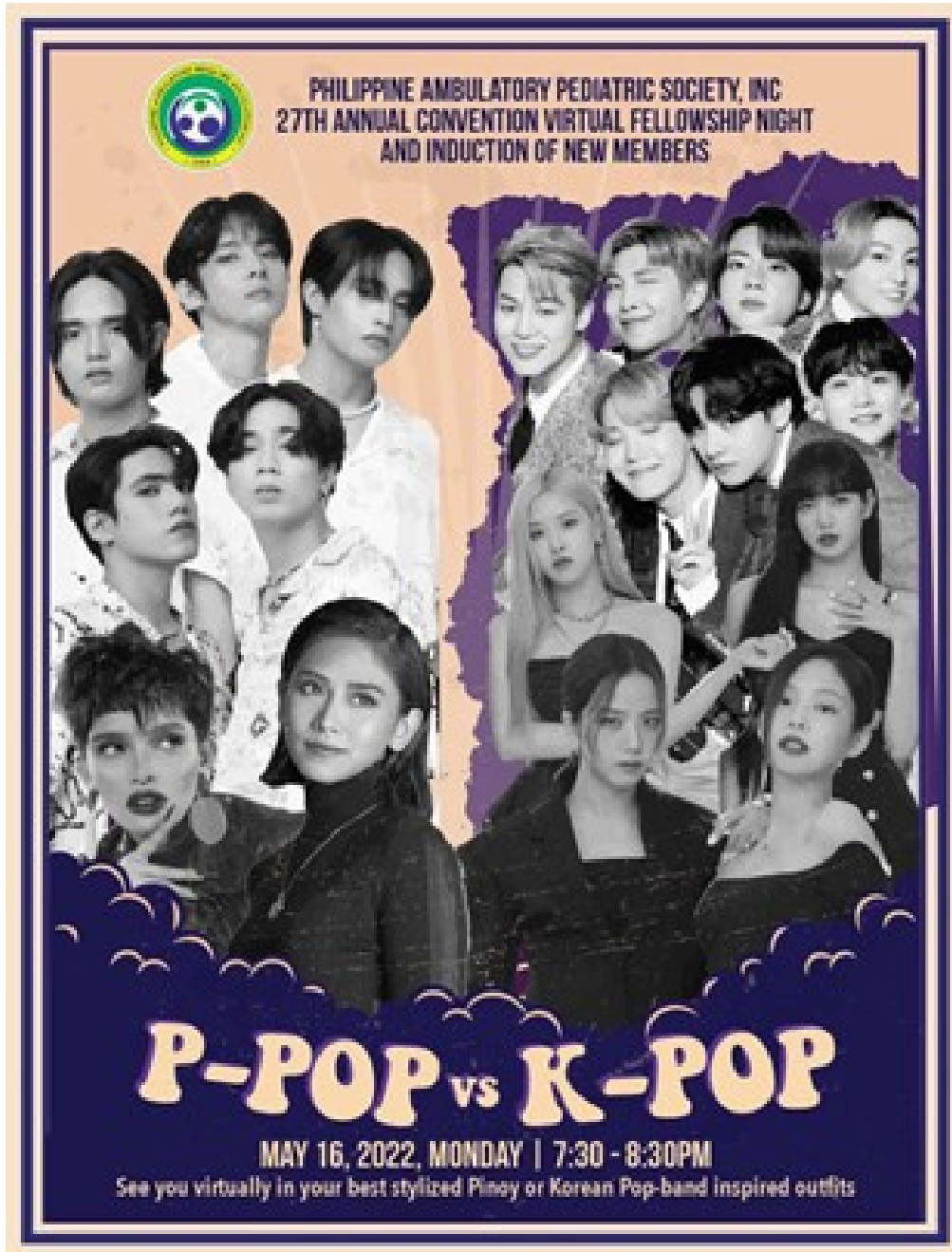
